Jack Lynch is the Chief Operating Officer at EducationSuperHighway, a nonprofit focused on closing the digital divide for the 18 million households that have access to the Internet but can't afford it. From 2012 to 2020, EducationSuperHighway helped to connect 47 million K-12 students to the minimum speed necessary for digital learning and secured commitments from governors in all 50 states to upgrade their schools for the 21st century.

Jack began his career as a hardware engineer at Cisco Systems but was driven to make a career change by a strong belief in the power of technology to create equitable opportunities for everyone. Jack has an Electrical Engineering degree from the University of Southern California's Viterbi School of Engineering.
